



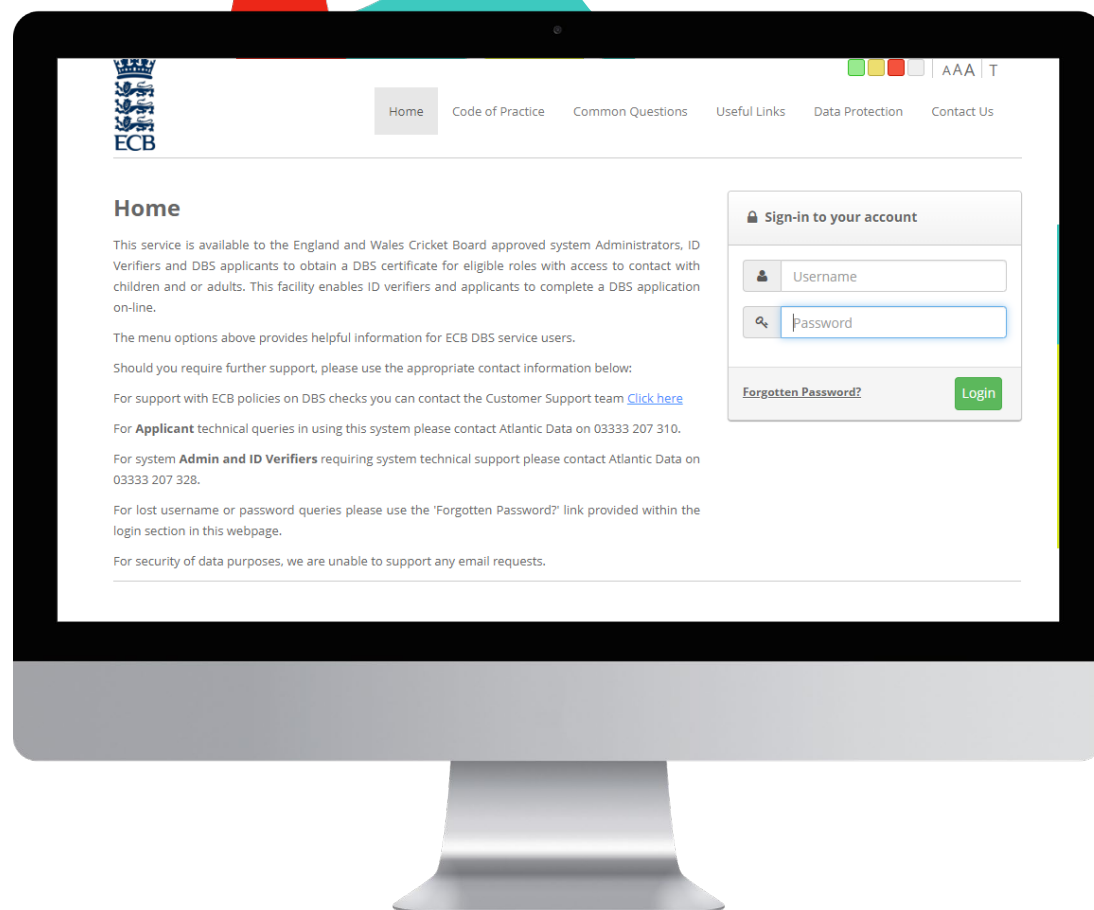
## DBS Update Service



Applying for an ECB DBS check is straightforward, and the process is now all online – there are no paper applications involved.

There is also the facility for you to enrol onto the Update Service which will mean that if your details do not change, you may never have to do another DBS application in cricket.

For renewal of your DBS on the update service, you will receive an email annually requiring you to log in and give consent to be rechecked and also confirm your personal details, such as: Role / Club / volunteer or paid status.

Dear [REDACTED],

ECB DBS Checks are only valid for 12 months and our records indicate that yours is about to expire.

Your clearance for regulated activity will automatically expire unless you log in and consent to a recheck via the Update Service.

ECB DBS checks are an essential part of ensuring we provide a safe environment for children in cricket, your current DBS check will expire on **30 days**. After this date, your ECB DBS will no longer be valid.

In order to renew your ECB DBS you **MUST** log in to your account [HERE](#)

Once you have activated your account and set a password your Username: [REDACTED] can then be used for any future access.

You may have also received an email directly from the DBS Update Service to renew your subscription. Please note that unless you log into your ECB account your clearance can not be renewed.

This email refers directly to your DBS Update Service subscription and is from the Disclosure and Barring Service – not the ECB.

They will advise that no action is required to keep a volunteer account active (paid applicants will need to make an annual payment of £13), **however** for the ECB to recheck the certificate and continue clearance you need to follow the instructions in the ECB email. You **must** give consent and confirm your details before the check can take place.
